Student Affairs PNG Policy

The Institute may restrict access to the campus by any visitor (i.e., a person who is neither an enrolled student nor an active employee of Caltech), including but not limited to guests, event attendees, and/or alumni whose conduct, after review by Caltech Security, is determined to be in violation of any Caltech policies or applicable California State Law.

In regards to active or enrolled students, only the Deans of Graduate or Undergraduate Studies or their designee have the authority to <u>remove</u> a current student from any campus space. This includes residences, specific buildings and/or activities, except in the case of directives issued by the Title IX Coordinator. Individual groups or residences do not have the authority to ban any student from access to activities, buildings or spaces, and any effort to do so will be considered a possible violation of the Honor Code.
